Key workers

In January a lot of children will be moving age groups, meaning your child may get a new key worker. As you know, being in together, means all the staff know all the children well, however, staff plan activities according to the development and learning needs of the children within their group. This means as the child gets older, they will learn in different ways. Our staff are highly skilled at implementing learning into play and teaching independence. In the new year, parents will receive information about their current (or new) key worker. We pride ourselves on our partnership with parents, so if you have any queries or concerns with regards to key workers, do not hesitate to get in touch.
